2 the following:

3 **SECTION 1. INVESTIGATION INTO THE DEPARTMENT OF**
4 **GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY.**

5 (a) AUDIT.—The Inspector General of the Social Se-
6 curity Administration shall investigate the actions of the
7 Department of Government Efficiency with respect to the
8 Social Security Administration to examine—

9 (1) the extent to which members of the Depart-
10 ment of Government Efficiency illegally accessed or
11 disclosed information from any beneficiary data sys-
12 tem; and

1 (2) whether any such members of the Depart-
2 ment of Government Efficiency should be referred to
3 the Department of Justice for criminal prosecution.

4 (b) DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY.—
5 For purposes of this section, the term “Department of
6 Government Efficiency” means—

7 (1) the United States DOGE Service;

8 (2) the United States DOGE Service Tem-
9 porary Organization;

10 (3) any DOGE team (as defined in any of the
11 Executive orders described in subsection (c)(1));

12 (4) any entity established in accordance with, or
13 to implement, any Executive order described in sub-
14 section (c); and

15 (5) any successor entity to an entity described
16 in paragraphs (1) through (4).

17 (c) EXECUTIVE ORDERS.—The Executive orders de-
18 scribed in this subsection are—

19 (1) Executive Orders 14158, 14210, 14219,
20 and 14222 (90 Fed. Reg. 8441, 9669, 10583,
21 11095); and

22 (2) any other Executive order relating to any
23 entity described in paragraph (1), (2), (3), or (5) of
24 subsection (b).

1 (d) BENEFICIARY DATA SYSTEM DEFINED.—In this
2 section, the term “beneficiary data system” means a sys-
3 tem that is maintained by the Social Security Administra-
4 tion for the purposes of administering the Social Security
5 Act that—

6 (1) issues or records social security account
7 numbers;

8 (2) is used to determine eligibility for benefits
9 under such Act;

10 (3) to pay benefits under such Act; or

11 (4) otherwise contains records of personally
12 identifiable information, personal health information,
13 or Federal tax information of individuals receiving
14 or applying for a benefit under such Act.
